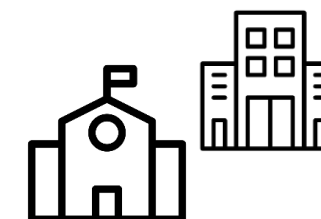

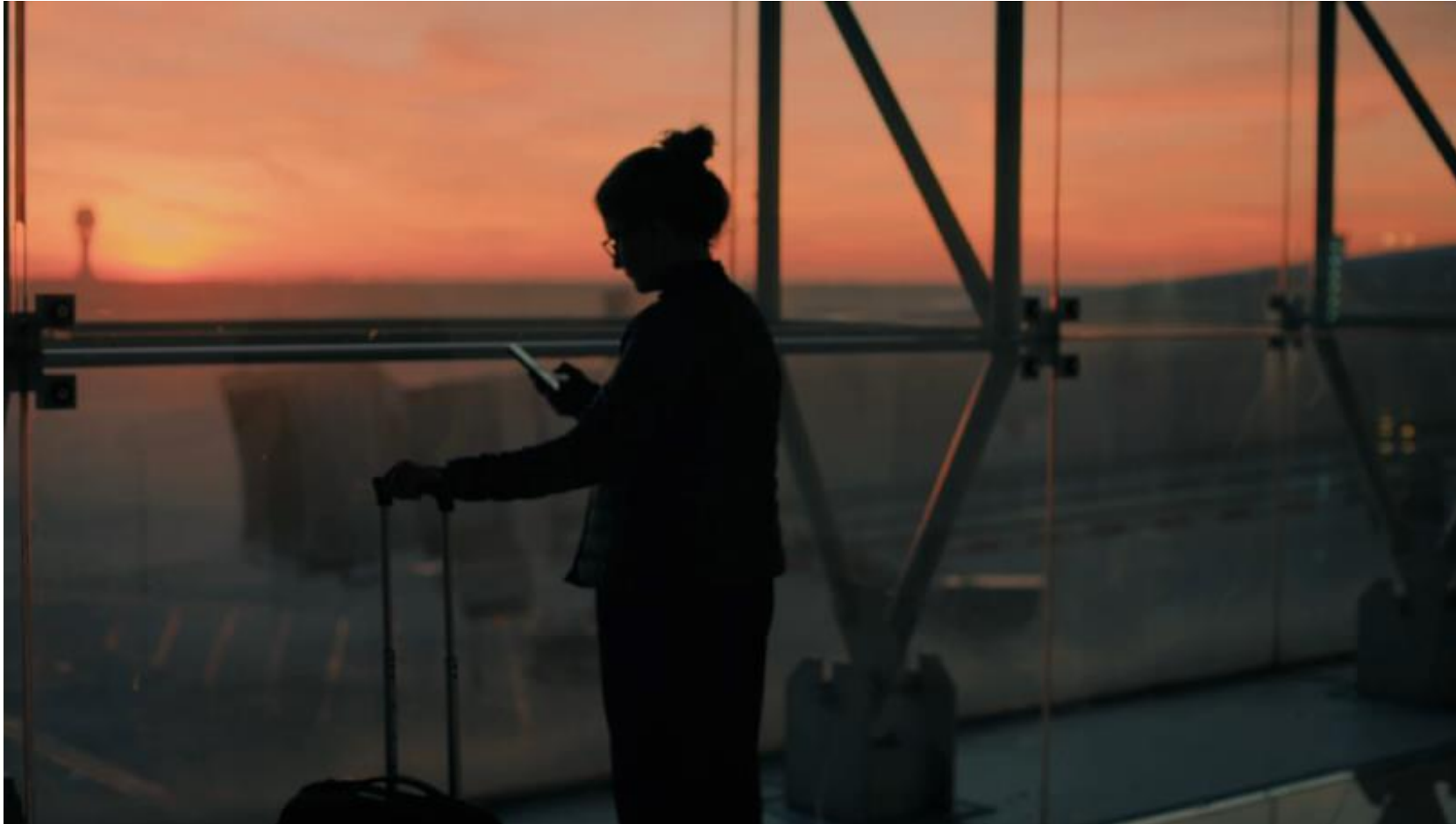

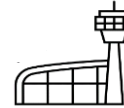

BARIG committees / working groups

Full Board Meeting		Joint meeting of all member airlines. Addressing key strategic and political issues. Key information from guest speakers about a wide range of topics.
Executive Committee		Meeting of BARIG airlines' delegates. Discussion of relevant topics of the industry. Joint decision-making and positioning.
Charges Committee		Information on current developments in airport charges. Analyzing and creating positions, processes, and measures for charges negotiations.
Technology & Innovation Committee		Discussion with technical experts and business partners. Consulting of legal aspects of distribution. Discovering new and innovative developments.
Infrastructure Committee		Input and evaluation of infrastructure developments at FRA, MUC, and other cost intensive airports. Joint positioning.
Arbitration Committee		Joint discussion and development of arbitration administration processes. Reducing cost and time-consuming processes.
Air Cargo & Logistics Committee		Development of all cargo related issues: security processes, regulations, handling processes, digitalization. Strengthening Germany's position on the international air transport market.

Infrastructure Committees

Airlines pay more than 4.7 billion Euro per year (2019) for the use of infrastructure on ground and in air

Passenger security:



550 m€ p.a.

Infrastructure:

Air Traffic Control:



1.4 bn€ p.a.

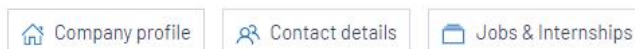

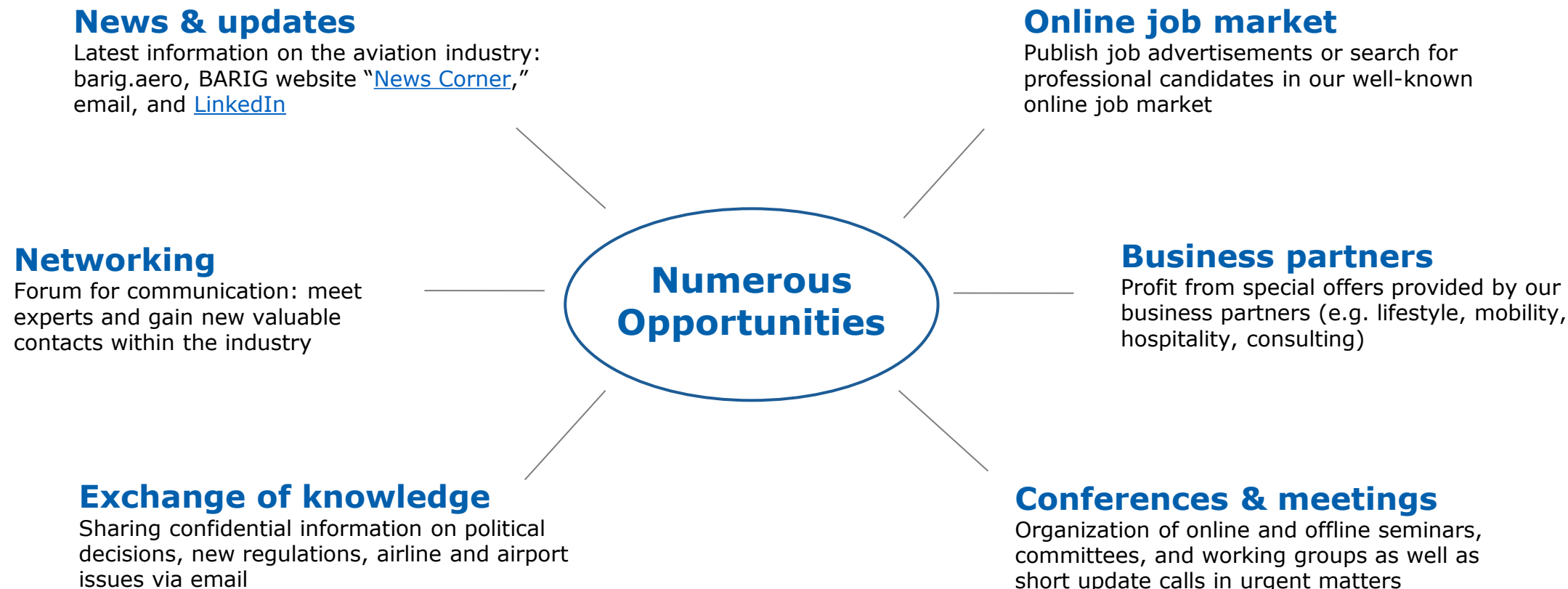
